# **Newborn Nursery Service:**

Valley Health physicians begin care for your child at birth. Our team of physicians first examine your son or daughter at the hospital nursery at Cabell Huntington Hospital. It is then important for your child to visit his or her doctor two or three days after going home from the hospital.

## **Vaccines:**

A critical component to your child's health is administration of vaccines that protect your child from disease.
